Current Projects.....



MBG continues to be involved in many projects including our **Widow Sponsorships**, which provides basic essentials including rice, cooking oil, peanut butter, bread, and soap. Most of these widows are caring for numerous family members with little to no provisions. Other projects include our **Emayani (Education for Widows)** group. We provide education and marketable skills for our “Mama’s” to help them become more self-sufficient. Their current project is making hand-woven baskets and mats. MBG also participates in **Health Care Outreach** visits with our Physician/Partner, Dr. Kenneth. This much needed service helps provide medical care to those who have no way to obtain this. Our outreach provides much needed wellness checks and screenings, medicines, and treatments.



Exciting News.....

MBG has just purchased 3 acres of land in the foothills of the Monduli region. Our dream has been to build a Community Center where God's love and kindness exists. The land is the first step towards this center; a place where a community can gather to be educated, share cooperative farming of coffee and fruit trees, vegetables and animals. There will be education brought to this center as many adults have never had the opportunity to learn even a single skill!

This center will be called The **IMPACT Center!** This stands for **I**nvestment, **M**ission, **P**raye**r**, **A**ction, **C**aring, and **T**eaching. Each of these words describes how we will take care of each soul that reaches our doors! God will always be the focus of how we love one another – ALL will be welcome from Monduli to all points around the world!
