Day 1. 16-Oct-25- Arriving in Tanzania

Your international flight will arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport, home to the 'The Roof of Africa', Mount Kilimanjaro. After clearing immigration and collecting your luggage, you'll be met by your driver who will be waiting for you at arrivals. You will drive to your accommodation in Arusha, and on a clear day, you may have views of Kilimanjaro en route. After a long day travelling you may want to rest, but if you want to keep yourself busy until the evening, we can arrange a city tour or other experiences dependent on your interests.

Day 2. 17-Oct-25- Spend the Day at Monduli (Community & Education Immersion Experience)

After a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, we'll drive to Monduli where you'll spend the day with MBG's Director and team visiting the communities we serve, including meeting widows in their traditional mud huts to understand their daily lives, participating in our monthly donation program, and hearing their powerful personal stories.

Day 3. 18-Oct-25- Spend the Day at Monduli (Community & Education Immersion Experience)

Today you'll visit a local primary school to witness the vibrant energy of Tanzanian students learning - we encourage bringing small gifts for the children and joining them during recess (they're eager to practice their budding English skills with visitors through simple conversations and games). Both experiences offer meaningful cultural exchange and unforgettable opportunities to connect with the local community.

Day 4. 19-Oct-25- Tarangire National Park

We will pick you up from your hotel at 8am and take you to a very special national park. Tarangire is famous for its diverse landscape with nine different vegetation zones. The park is particularly known for the abundance of Ancient Baobab trees (the largest trees in the continent) In fact, the park has the largest concentration of elephants in the whole country and provides unique chances to observe the interaction between elephant families.

The lunch area is fascinating, boasting an observatory with amazing views to the river and wildlife in the afternoon we will still do a game drive before continuing to your accommodation.

Day 5. 20-Oct-25- Ngorongoro Crater Excursion

A drive in the Ngorongoro Crater starts early. You'll be at the park gates when they open and your day starts with views over the largest intact volcanic caldera in the world. At 259 sq km (160 sq miles), the sheer size of the crater makes it difficult to comprehend the height of the towering walls, but the wind and clouds up here give you a hint. The rim of the crater sits around 610 m (2,001 ft) above the crater floor, and you'll begin your descent to a naturally contained ecosystem home to zebras, wildebeests, buffalo, lions, hyenas, jackals and even critically endangered black rhinos. You'll spend up to six hours in the crater before returning to Karatu.

Day 6. 21-Oct-25- Serengeti National Park

The drive from Karatu to the Serengeti will take you through Maasai settlements with wandering herds of cattle and round houses in the distance, and once you've crossed into the park you'll be on safari. The Serengeti is known for its endless grassy plains broken up only by rocky kopjes and the Gol Mountains in the distance, but the park also consists of a variety of landscapes, from acacia forests and rivers to soda lakes and granite mountains. Home to a healthy population of big cats, the Serengeti may give you wonderful sightings of lions lounging on the kopjes, leopards in the branches escaping the heat and cheetahs surveying the plains from the top of termite mounds. The Serengeti also hosts over 500 bird species, including a variety of bustards, bright lilac-breasted rollers and shimmering starlings

Day 7. 22-Oct-25- Serengeti National Park

The park is famous for the Great Migration, the annual journey of two million wildebeest and zebras from the plains of the Serengeti to the grasslands of the Masai Mara in Kenya. Instinct drives the herds from their birthing grounds to find fertile lands in the Mara to feed. The migration can be seen every month of the year, starting with the calving season in the southern Serengeti from January to March. After giving birth, the herds move north through the Serengeti, eventually arriving at the

banks of the Mara River, swollen by the floods of the rains and teeming with crocodiles. The herds must cross to find fresh grazing and plunge into the river by the thousands. Those that survive the crossing must stay alert enough to avoid the big cats lurking on the far side. At some point, the grasses will be exhausted and as birth time once again approaches, the herds will wander back south. If you would like to see the migration, you need to plan your safari to be in the right places at the right times.

Upon arrival, you'll be treated to a delicious hot lunch at Arusha Coffee Lodge, reflecting on the unforgettable memories of your safari adventure as you prepare for your onward journey.

After your lunch you may want to relax at Planet lodge for the day room booked for you to refreshen before you are transferred to the Kilimanjaro Airport for your international flight.
