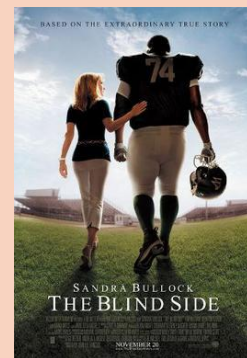
In The News.....
