MBG is blessed to have grown in our work in Tanzania. Founder, Pamela Wendtland, was touched to be reconnected to a community in the central part of the country called Chardeleco. This community has over 300 people that have been affected by leprosy at one point in their life. The bacteria ravaged their extremities and left them disabled. Unfortunately, they do not have help with local or national leaders. God placed us there for a purpose and reason-we will begin providing monthly food to them, so their bellies are filled. This is a huge undertaking as the village is far away from where our normal day to day activities take place. Another partnership has begun! MBG will serve a rural primary school called Green Hope. This school has a very sweet beginning. It began as a church with services on Sunday. One of the members of the church saw that the space was unused most days and grew this to become a school that is operating with biblical principles and kindness with its humble leaders. They care deeply about the children who are unable to attend school because they lack the ability to have a uniform, shoes to transport them back and forth to school, and supplies needed to participate in class. The leaders of the school travel to find the families who are struggling and invite their children to "just come"! God has a great way of making things work out for those in need and he sent our team in early April. We brought notebooks, pencils, teaching supplies, and shared snacks with them. They see our hearts and know whatever we can do for them we will. It is an honor to know that each item we take to them is making a difference in the young lives that want to learn. Currently there are 80 children and 3 teachers, a head mistress, and a headmaster that oversee these young lives. Please keep them in your prayers.
