We understand that in Tanzania a woman carries a huge load but in the Kayuni family, everyone helps! Culturally speaking, men typically are not involved in raising kids and housework, but David, Fadhili, and Veron are changing that trajectory for their generation. They do household chores, run errands, and do all the things that aren’t “normal”. Fibi runs a tight ship, and we love that about her!

Mission Barista “Global” was named that way because of our desire to not stop at any borders. Our founder, **Pamela Wendtland**, gets called into many different activities and conversations. She was connected to a ministry in **Pakistan** several months ago. They are a Christian church that goes into the remote areas and is helping a large group of people that are human slaves. They are Brick/Kiln workers. They make bricks in the most unimaginable conditions. They work outside in unbearable heat 14-18 hours a day. They are paid minimal wages and are given little in the way of housing and food.

They have found that learning the Bible is helping them find peace and hope. MBG has been able to offer some funding for audio Bibles and food to help fill their hungry bellies. We know that our meeting was not by chance but by divine guidance. We will move forward, helping as we are able by bringing more audio bibles and food, so they stay strong in the conditions in which they live and work. 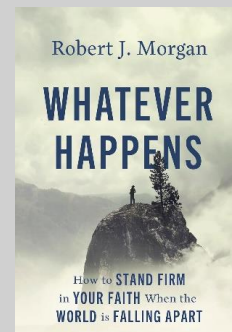


Summer Sampler.....
