# Tanzania Mission Trip, Safari and Zanzibar January 2026

# Day 1. 17-Jan KLM (JRO) 8:30pm

Arrive at JRO airport where you will be greeted by your guide and TZ mission team. Transportation to nearby Lodge for a bite to eat and a lovely restful night in Tanzania Africa.

# Day 2. 18-Jan Acclimation in Arusha

You will awake to the beautiful sounds of Tanzania and will walk to have a warm, delicious and gratifying breakfast in the main house of Planet Lodge. After breakfast we will make our way into Arusha where we will stop to visit the Maasai Market, exchange any money that you would like to pick up any necessities (extra bottled water or anything) as we will make a stop at the local grocery store. We will make our way to our next accommodation (Kahawa House) where we will settle into our rooms and begin our organization for the mission. We will meet the team and do our briefing. There is a pool at Kahawa House and if you wish to swim and acclimate this will be the best day for that. After our team gathers and works to coordinate efforts – we will have a beautiful dinner prepared by the famous "Chef Erik" after dinner we will rest for the night.

### Day 3.4 and 5 19, 20 and 21st - Jan Monduli Juu - Medical Outreach

As we set out for Monduli Juu, the sun illuminated the landscape casting a warm glow over the rolling hills and alleys. The excitement of the day ahead fueled our spirits, knowing that our mission would touch the lives of many individuals and families.

After our day of health care outreach is over – we will head back to the Kahawa House for a decompression of the day, and we will refresh and enjoy a beautiful dinner cooked to the highest standards by "Chef Erik" After dinner – you can return to your room and rest until the next morning sun greets you.

If time allows after each outreach clinic ends – we may stop by and visit the Green Hope Primary School and possible a few of the widows that Mission Barista Global has been working with for many years. You will see hope that each soul MBG has touched knows the work we do.

### Day 6, 7 and 8 22, 23 and 24 – Jan Singida / Nkungi (Leper Community)

After we have had our wonderful breakfast at Kahawa House – we ill start our journey to Nkungi Village, a drive that will take approximately 6.5-8 hours covering over 200 miles. The drive takes patience and positivity. The roads are a bit of a challenge getting to Singida so your "Core" will have a bit of a workout. Bring your headphones with you as you will have plenty of time to listen to a podcast or 3 – listen to music – Chat with one another. There is much beauty along the way, and you will enjoy this opportunity.

Upon arrival our team will work collaboratively with local health, government and local leaders to understand their specific needs and challenges. We will participate in health

assessments, provide medical consultations and distribute necessary supplies such as OTC items, hygiene products and educational materials.

We will begin our journey back to Arusha (Kahawa House) and arrive in the evening of the 24<sup>th</sup> where you will need to repack and be ready for our next adventure – SAFARI and ZANZIBAR!

# Day 9, 10 and 11

# 25th-27 Jan Fly to Serengeti for Safari

To avoid the longer drive through the southern Serengeti and Ngorongoro, you will board a light aircraft at Arusha Airport (which is VERY close to Kahawa House) which will fly directly to the central Serengeti. This region is characterized by the unique convergence of the southern short grass plains and acacia woodlands, complimented by the Ngare Nanyuki underground river, which creates pockets of permanent water that sustain a diverse array of wildlife year-round. The abundance of accessible prey fosters significant big cat activity, and the striking rocky kopjes scattered across the plains serve as prime observation points for cheetahs, lions and leopards. Additionally, the Serengeti is home to over 500 bird species, including various bustards, the vibrant lilac-breasted roller, and dazzling starlings. You will see Giraffe, Elephants and every beautiful creature there is!

for you and you will be welcomed warmly by the host of this beautiful property each evening.

Day 14 30 - Jan Zanzibar – JRO

After your leisurely breakfast at the villas – you will be transferred to the airport for your afternoon flight to JRO. Upon arrival, you will mee the transfer personnel and they will take you to Planet Lodge where you will have a day room to shower, repack and refresh before you depart back to JRO for your flight back to USA.
